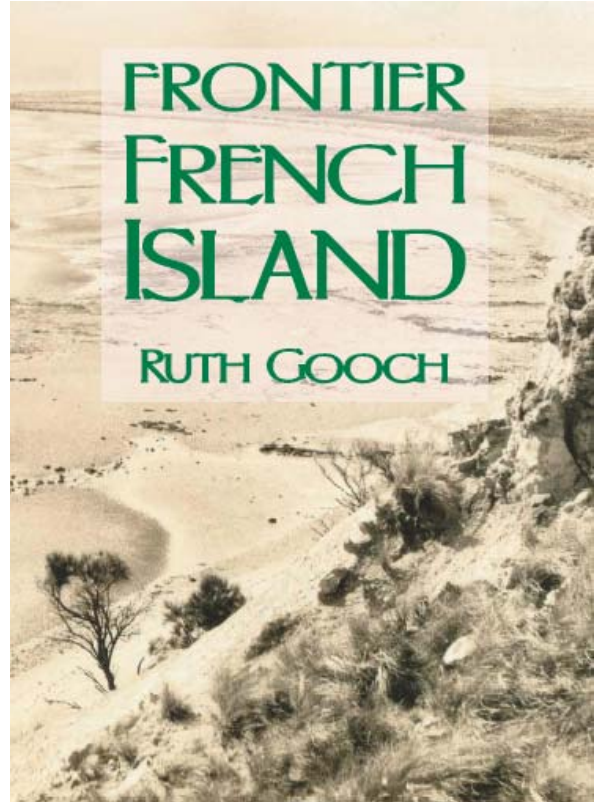

Meticulously researched over a period of ten years, material was retrieved from both national and international sources. Fifteen chapters examine the various aspects of island life since the 1800s - farms, felons, and *fun*, the latter, in spite of the isolation and hardships. A fresh look is taken at the question of the island's discovery: was it really the French? What role did Archdeacon Hindley play in regard to the administration of the circuitous Dyott endowment?
